

5. <u>NOTES</u>

The Rounds:

- Detailed timetables showing arbitrators and teams will be provided on the day.
- On **Saturday**, each team will plead in **4 rounds (1.5 hours each)**; twice for Claimant and twice for Respondent. We will try to make sure you always compete against different teams, and mix common law against civil law teams.





- Teams who have made it to the final Sunday rounds are announced on Saturday evening.
- On **Sunday morning** the four highest scoring teams will take part in the semi-finals. The 1st and 2nd team will then compete in the Grand Final while the 3rd and 4th team compete for the Third Place in the play-off.
- All teams are welcome to watch any of the rounds subject to space and subject to you not being scheduled against a team in Vienna. There will be a break room with refreshments where teams can wait in between rounds.
- The final winners are then announced on Sunday afternoon. The moot will close on Sunday by 2:30pm.

Refreshments:

- Tea, coffee and biscuits will be provided throughout both days; a sandwich lunch is provided on Saturday only. Please advise us of any dietary requirements in advance.
- Whilst waiting for the results on Saturday evening, drinks will be offered for the teams at the CIArb, at Bloomsbury Square, to give you the chance to get to know each other and to get to know us and some of the arbitrators.

Travel: London's transport network

a) Map of the London Underground:

London has an underground train network called the Tube. Please see a link to a map of this. You can also download the tube map app on smart phones. http://content.tfl.gov.uk/standard-tube-map.pdf

b) Map of wider train network:

This shows the trains you can take from the various airports into the central London. <u>http://content.tfl.gov.uk/london-rail-and-tube-services-map.pdf</u>

<u>Tickets</u>: you can buy single underground tickets or use **London Oyster cards** for multiple journeys which you top up with money.

Please note the London underground often has **no lifts** and lots of stairs. Changing multiple times with suitcases can be a bit of a hassle.

Flights/ Getting Here

Please make sure you give yourself plenty of time to travel to/from the airport, in order to check-in, go through security and catch your flight.

There are 3 main airport options.

a) Stansted Airport (North of London)

- The **Stansted Express** (train tickets) can be bought at the station for circa £28 return or booked online in advance (cheaper from £7 or with groups).
- It is a flexible return ticket allowing you to take any train at any time.
- The trains come every 15 minutes and only takes just under 1 hour directly to London Liverpool Street Station (near the office)

b) Gatwick (South of London)

- All train tickets can be bought at the station from ticket machines
- Trains go directly from Gatwick Airport to London Victoria station (£15 for 35 mins- this is the most frequent route) or London Bridge (£9 for 1 hour) or London St Pancras International Train station (£9 for 1 hour) [*these are only approximate prices and times*]

c) Heathrow (West of London)

 There is a train (30 mins at £10-22) directly into Central London, or a direct underground line (Piccadilly Line) taking 51mins to Kings Cross St Pancras Station, where you change lines for Moorgate
